

GENERAL STALLHOLDER INFORMATION

CALOUNDRA TWILIGHT MARKET (TWM)

LAST FRIDAY OF THE MONTH 5PM-9PM

Held on the last Friday of each month (excluding June and July) the Caloundra Twilight Market takes over 2 blocks of the Esplanade at Bulcock Beach. This event literally “pops up” in the space as we bring in toilets, rubbish bins and a generator to power our food stalls.

Our road closure commences at 2pm with Bump In divided into 3 groups, which will be allocated via email prior to Market day. Each group is assigned an arrival time, starting from 2:30pm.

BUMP IN

- Bump in to the Caloundra Twilight Markets is via one entrance only. Please enter via Minchinton Street, turning right onto the Esplanade. From there you will be within the road closure precinct, please ensure your hazard lights are on and you are driving at a walking pace of no more than 10km/h
- Market staff will meet you just past the crossing, opposite the Ithica Surf Club. From here you will be assigned your location and given directions.
- Please park and unload as quickly as possible and remove your car from the area.
- To exit, you must use the Otranto Avenue intersection in the middle of the market.
- Parking is available outside the road closure in Leeding Terrace.
- Market trade commences at 5pm, however it is very common to have many customers around prior to this.

BUMP OUT

- The TWM officially finishes at 9pm. Market Management will give instruction when vehicles are permitted to be brought into the precinct.
- Vehicle entrance is again from the Minchinton Street end of the market. Hazard lights must be on and 10km/h max speed limit observed.
- Please pack up as quickly as possible, minimising the obstruction of other stallholders.
- Exit is via the Otranto Avenue intersection in the middle of the market.
- Please ensure all rubbish is removed from the site and not placed in the Market bins, also check your area thoroughly, especially for zip ties.
- The road MUST reopen by 10pm.

POWER

Our event electrician will be setting up from 3pm. If required and requested, you will receive power as soon as possible. Please be patient! For any problems with access to power on the day, please contact the Event Manager directly.

All electrical equipment, appliances and cords must be tested and tagged by a qualified electrical contractor in accordance with Queensland Electrical Safety Regulations 2002 and subsequent amendments. Stallholders found with non-complying or unsafe appliances or cords will have power withdrawn without notice. Please make sure all tags dates are current.
